RACE DESCRIPTIONS

Cross Country

One of the only point to point races still around. This course has it all: narrow single track, big lung busting fire road climbs and long screaming descents. Water provided by Crystal Springs Water company. Payout will be given to the 3 fastest times for riders on the long course. 1st place will receive \$100, 2nd \$50, and 3rd will receive \$20.

Distances: Beginner: 9 miles, Sport: 15 miles, Pro/Expert: 24 miles

Dual Slalom

Two courses merge into one for an exciting head to head race on our improved dual slalom course with big berms and jumps. One qualifying run. The 16 fastest qualifiers in each category will go head to head in single elimination rounds. Fastest qualifier in each race gets lane choice.

Downhill

Single Run format. Our downhill course is 100% single track and features tight turns, high speed G-outs, and exciting drops. New this year rock gardens will challenge your skills while taking you through the trees. Bypasses are given for most obstacles. Expert and Sport courses are different. Payout will be given to the 3 fastest times for riders on the Expert course. 1st place will receive \$100, 2nd \$50, and 3rd will receive \$20.

Short Track

Fast paced and action packed XC racing that is as fun to watch as it is to race. Laps will be around a modified course from previous years. Bring your lungs – you're going to need them. NORBA racers will race with corresponding collegiate category due to time constraints.

Pixie Bike Action

There really is no way to explain this. Just make sure you are there Saturday night with a costume and a bike with 16" wheels or smaller. Be ready to have fun!

CAMPING/ENTRY

\$5.00 per a vehicle. Strict enforcement.

WHAT TO BRING

Water, toilet paper, food, and camping equipment. On-site primitive camping and flush toilets are provided. For the less adventuresome, lodging is available at the Parkfield Inn: (805) 463-2421. Be sure to call early because they will fill up.

HOW TO GET THERE

The V6 Ranch is Located approximately 3 miles north of the town of Parkfield. Parkfield, CA is located 30 minutes north-east of Paso Robles, CA. Parkfield is in the middle of nowhere so make sure you have enough gas and bring a map because it is easy to get lost.

From 101 - Hwy 46 East in Paso Robles:

Continue East past Cholame. Turn left on Parkfield Rd. right before the 41/46 split. Take Parkfield/Cholame Rd. for 15 miles to the town of Parkfield. Turn Right over the bridge to go into Parkfield. The Ranch is 3 miles past the town. Signs will be posted.

From I-5:

Go west on Hwy 41/46 until the 41/46 merge. Immediately turn right on Parkfield Rd. Take Parkfield/Cholame Rd. for 15 miles to the town of Parkfield. Turn Right over the bridge to go into Parkfield. The Ranch is 3 miles past the town. Signs will be posted.
