Santa Teresa XC: This 6-mile course has it all: tight, technical singletrack, wide-open fireroad, screaming descents and killer climbs. This course will be challenging and is sure to produce some exciting racing. Course will be a clockwise loop. (See course map)

Rocky Ridge Super D: This fast and furious descent of the Rocky Ridge trail drops down from Coyote Peak, finishing near the parking and registration area. Course is ~1.7 miles over a 500' decent. Riders will start in one-minute intervals. No Shuttle will be provided.

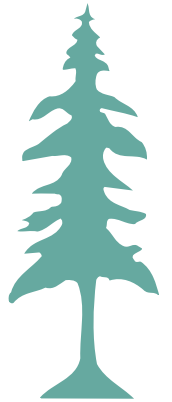
Registration open at 11:30 and closes 15 minutes prior to the start of each event.

Fees / Licenses:

\$15 per event

Collegiate-only licenses valid for collegiate athletes. We will be selling one-day and annual licenses at registration. Riders competing in category "A" must have an annual license.

Directions: Santa Teresa Park offers an array of fantastic singletrack and fireroad trails and is conveniently located just off Highway 101/85, on Bernal Road in south San Jose. Take 101 to Bernal Road in San Jose and take a right, heading southwest. Park entrance is 2 miles past Santa Teresa Blvd. Santa Teresa Park is a facility of the County of Santa Clara Regional Parks and Recreation System.

Parking: There is a \$4/vehicle parking fee, and parking is limited. Parking is ONLY permitted in designated spots in the park's paved parking lots. Any vehicle outside of a marked spot, on the dirt, or along the access road will be ticketed by the Park Ranger. Overflow parking is available in the Knob Hill shopping center northwest of the intersection of Santa Teresa Blvd and Bernal road.

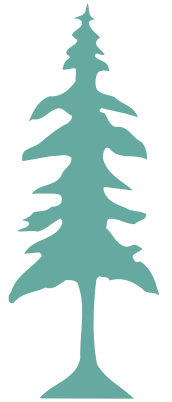
