RULES

Sky Tavern is an awesome facility, so please observe the following rules on race days so we have the privilege of using this facility again in the future:

HOW TO GET THERE

SKY TAVERN: 21130 MT. ROSE HWY | RENO | NEVADA

FROM NORCAL:

- Take exit 15 to merge onto US-395 S toward Carson City
- Take exit 56 to merge onto Mt Rose Hwy/NV-431 (to the W!) toward Mt Rose/No. Lake Tahoe (first right is into a Raley's)
- From the intersection of NV-431 and Wedge Parkway (the first stoplight, near Raley's) continue on NV-431 for 10.3 miles.
- Just after making a left-hand switchback, there will be a turn to the right where the road flattens. YOU'RE THERE!

FROM SOCAL:

- Figure out how to get on US-395 N somewhere before Lone Pine.
- Drive N on US-395 N a long damn ways (past Competitive Edge MX). Watch for desert critters and burning man riff-raff who didn't make it home!
- Turn left onto Mt Rose Hwy/NV-431 (to the W!). About a mile up on the right (after passing under an overpass) is the Raley's.
- From the intersection of NV-431 and Wedge Parkway (the first stoplight, near Raley's) continue on NV-431 for 10.3 miles.
- Just after making a left-hand switchback, there will be a turn to the right where the road flattens. YOU'RE THERE!

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

CROSS COUNTRY

The course features a steady climb, followed by about 1.5 miles of up-and-down single track. Then, a fast single-track descent with lots of dg, a short climb, and more mixed descending to lodge. Each lap is 6 miles.

Start Order	Laps
MA, Pro, Semi-Pro, Expert M	4
MB, Sport M, Junior Ex M	3
WA, Pro W, Expert W	3
MC, Beginner M, Junior M	2
WB, Junior Expert W	2
Beginner W, Junior W	1

SUPER-D

The course will connect two sections of the XC course with a ripping section of Kamikaze-style road. No major uphill! Same finish as XC.

Notes:

- SD shuttle drop-off point is across from main Mt. Rose Ski Area parking lot (this is less than .25 miles past the drop off point for the DH).
- Start order: MA, MB, WA, MB, WC
- Le-mans mass start
- Collegiate only

DOWNHILL

Technical dg single-track followed by short road section into final section of tight single-track through trees. Course time is about 2.5 minutes. Collegiate MC/WB and NORBA Beginners will skip upper single-track and use road instead.

Notes:

- Collegiate start order: MA, MB, WA, MC, WB
- NORBA start order: will depend on turn-out
- Shuttle: From the Sky Tavern parking lot, drive 2-miles up Mt. Rose Highway. On the right, there will be a turn-out lane followed by a big cut-bank. Un-load there. Walk past the chain, and follow signs. There will not be an organized shuttle.
- Drop-off point is at last corner BEFORE Mt. Rose Ski Area parking lot.

SHORT TRACK

Collegiate only. The short track will run in the parking lot/lodge area of the resort. The laps will be announced Saturday night and will be posted for registration on Sunday morning.
