Course: Same course as 2005-2006. One half mile. Three right corners and one sweeping turn. 1/3 flat, 1/3 up, 1/3 down with ~20 ft of climbing per lap (hence, *Anthill*). Mostly good pavement with one tricky downhill corner and some bots-dots. Nice wide roads and a long, rising finish.

Directions: Located next to the UC Irvine School of Medicine in the University Research Park at the corner of Bison and California. Coming from the 405 or 55, take the 73 S, exit Bison and turn left. Go two blocks, through UCI stone gates, and turn right on California. Parking is available in the Research Park.

Fees: Make checks payable to "Bike Club at UCI." Collegiate team pay accepted. 2nd race of the day is \$10. \$5 late fee for registration after Wednesday, April 2. Pre-reg can be sent to UCI Anteater Recreation Center, ATTN: Bike Club, 680 California Ave., Irvine, CA 92697-4545, or register online at www.sportsbaseonline.com. No late fee for collegiate races. 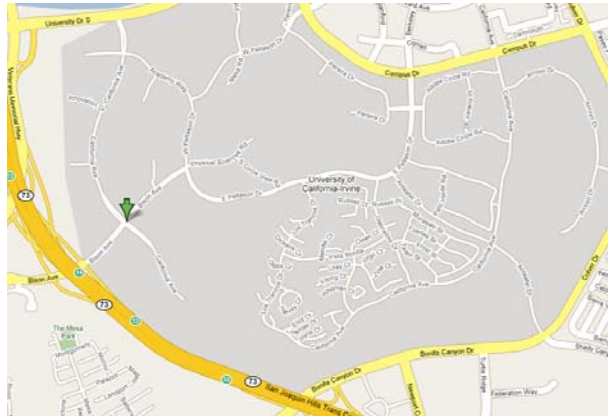
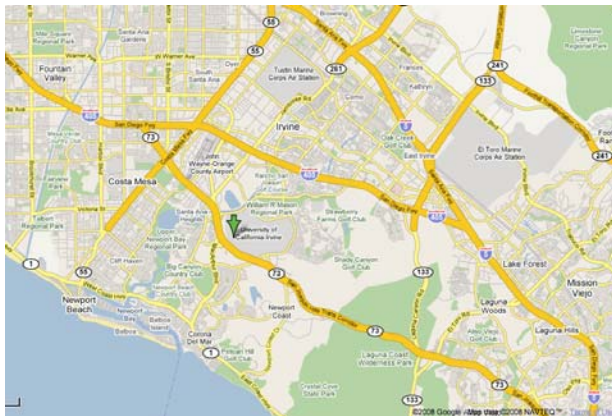

Registration: Registration will open at 7 a.m. and will close for the field 15 min prior to each race.

Prizes: Prizes will be guaranteed for the first prime of each race. For collegiate races, this will be granted to the *team* of the winner. Prime prizes include great merchandise from our sponsors Rudy Project, GU, and GU20.

Conducted under USAC rules and regulations. A **75 rider field limit is set on all races except the Pro/1/2 race, which is 80 and Mens 5, which is 50**. Helmets must be worn at all times. Course is closed to traffic. Held rain or shine. USAC and NCCA rules apply. Riders out of contention may be pulled from the race. Wheels in/wheels out pit. Free lap rule until 5 laps to go. Combining collegiate fields is up to the judgment of the race director, however, combined fields will still be scored separately.
