The race promoter may combine fields if there are 15 riders or fewer in a race.

† Riders will be assigned to 5-A and 5-B races, to balance field size, in order of registration.

**Rules:** Race runs rain or shine. All USCF and NCCA rules apply. Riders must wear helmets at all times. Course is open to traffic; obey all traffic regulations. Centerline rule is strictly enforced. Littering on the course is prohibited. You will get no warning—you will be disqualified and fined by the CHP on your first offense.

**Licenses:** All riders must have a valid USCF license or proof of pending license. One-day and annual licenses can be purchased. All foreign riders must present a valid 2008 UCI license.

**Registration:** Online registration is available through [sportsbaseonline.com](http://sportsbaseonline.com) until January 29th, 2008. Entries received after January 23, 2008 will incur a \$5 late fee. Mail-in registration is not accepted. Day-of registration closes 10 minutes before category start and is open at 6:00am on February 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**Directions:** The course is about one hour east of downtown San Diego. Take I-5 south to I-8 east toward El Centro. Travel approximately 60 miles to Crestwood/Live Oak Springs exit. Turn right off the exit and head straight on Old Hwy 80. Follow signs to the staging area near the gas station/mini-mart on Royal Dr.

**Course:** A 22.4 mile road course with rollers and a long climb to the finish. Staging area is at the intersection of Royal Dr. and Old Hwy 80. The course descends on Old Hwy 80, turns right on Tierra Del Sol Rd., right on Hwy 94, right on La Posta, and right on to Old Hwy 80. Parking at the finish is allowed only on the south side past the finish line; extra parking is available around the corner.

**Feed Zone:** The feed zone is before the intersection of Old Hwy 80 and Crestwood, just after the finishing area. Feeding will only be allowed during races with at least 3 laps.

**Mechanical Support:** Follow vehicles will provide wheels-in-wheels-out support for each category. Full neutral support will be provided by Wheels on Wheels for the Men Pro/1/2 field.

**Claiming Prizes:** Prizes will be distributed at the Live Oak Springs staging area within 1 hour of race results being posted. All prizes not claimed at the race are forfeit.
